

Historic moment


On Wednesday 4 May 2022, Delegates from Baphalane Traditional Council, Rrangwane Ntshite, Mr P. Thompo accompanied Kgosi JEM Ramokoka to the Department of Public Works and Roads in Mafikeng to meet leadership of the department. Mr M Moremi, the Department Administrator was also accompanied by Ms E. Kgang from legal services and Mr A. Mafune from Roads Management to witness this historic moment.

Kgosi JEM Ramokoka and Mr Moremi signed the Memorandum of Understanding in partnership with Batlase Development Trust to deliver high quality tar-road to the residents and users of roads in and around Ramokokastad.

THE PROCESS



The Administrator, Mr Moremi explained the process that will unfold after the MOU was signed. Pending National Treasury approval process, the Department of Public Works and Roads NW will issue a tender for construction of phase 1 of the tar road project at a later date that will be announced. It is expected that construction of the much awaited tar road will bring job opportunities to residents, attract developers to invest in the community, and benefit local business owners and the transport sector to name a few, said Kgosi Ramokoka. The Administrator further promised to keep the communications lines open with Baphalane community through the Traditional Council on progress, until completion of the road construction.
